Company History

Surgi Manufacturing Company, Inc. has been owned and operated for 60 years by the Surgi family. Brothers David and Paul owe their success to their grandfather and his beliefs. He believed that to be successful, you must be customer orientated. Their father continued this policy throughout the years and now David and Paul continue with those same principles with Secure Firearm Products, Inc.

The Surgi family have always been a supporter of the 2nd Amendment and joined the NRA eight years ago when a brother-in-law gave the brothers a gift membership. They increasingly became supporters of the NRA and the whole family became involved in shooting sports through the Missouri 4-H, as instructors and 4-H members.

As the customer base of the business changed, Surgi Manufacturing began looking for a new source of energy and direction. They found that energy in the shooting sports industry. In the aftermath of 9/11/01, they saw a need for a firearms case that was not able to be broken into by someone using ordinary tools. This was the idea behind the completely internal locking system developed for the line of security cases and the newly developed company Secure Firearm Products, Inc.

In 2003 Secure Firearm Products became a sponsor for the *Women On Target Program* and the cases were soon distributed all over the country at various shoots throughout the year. In July of 2003 they were a sponsor at the 2003 Pan American World FITASC Cup Championship, and a sponsor of the 2003 World FITASC Championship. At that time several cash prizes and shotgun cases were given to competitors.

The year 2004 was a very busy year for Secure Firearm Products as they introduced their high security cases and the company at the 2004 SHOT Show. The cases were well received by retailers, distributors, media, and guests. Many who stopped at the New Product Center made a beeline to their booth to find out more about the locking system in the cases and the company. They soon became involved with the Women's Recreational Shooting Association and donated several cases for their Women's Charity Shoots throughout the year. In May of 2004, they were sponsors at the NRA Bianchi Cup where several handgun cases were given as prizes top competitors from all over the world. Since Secure Firearm Products was a newcomer to the NRA Bianchi Cup, they presented the Newcomer Award to NRA Bianchi Cup newcomer Jason Koon. At that time, they also introduced their steel Wall Vaults. In July of 2004 David and his family headed for the National Matches in Camp Perry as volunteers and vendors during the Pistol Matches.

In February of 2005, brothers David and Paul took their families to Las Vegas and introduced the company's newest product, the Porta-Safe. The Porta-Safe was a hit with the law enforcement attendees as well as those looking for a secure place to secure a handgun on a smaller scale. Secure Firearm Products was a sponsor at the 2005 NRA Bianchi Cup and the company had the great pleasure of awarding 1st place to the top woman champion, Vera Koo.. In July of 2005, David again took his family to the NRA National Matches for 5 weeks, where David and his

daughter volunteered and other family members took care of the company vendor booth. They also had a Laser Shot (simulated shooting system) set up for a little R&R for competitors and visitors.

Brothers David and Paul joined their local gun club in 2004 and over the past year had discovered that there was not enough exciting and challenging target systems available. Soon they began developing a target system that was not only extremely fun to shoot and challenging, and was also able to change and adapt to the shooter's ability. The Shooting Star was the first prototype of a target system and was introduced at Camp Perry. By the time the 2006 SHOT Show came around, they had several targets available including two sizes of the Shooting Star, a Single Swinger, and a Double Swinger with a Stop.

In May of 2006, Secure Firearm Products were Side Event Match Sponsors with a competition using the Shooting Star and the Double Swinger with a Stop. Everyone who had a chance to shoot had a blast. Paul's daughter Theresa presented Tony Holmes with a Secure Firearm Products Handgun case as the top winner in that side event match. David's daughter, Sydney, presented the top NRA Bianchi Cup woman's award to Vera Koo. In July of 2006, Secure Firearm Products were very proud to be stage sponsors at the 15th Annual Smith & Wesson Revolver Championships. At that time, several of the target system combinations were used in the match as well as given away for competitor prizes.

Secure Firearm Products and the Surgi family continue to support the shooting sports industry through their contributions to the NSSF, NRA Bianchi Cup, 4-H Shooting Sports, ICORE, USPSA, Friends of NRA, and many other shooting sports entities. Secure Firearm Products continues to research, develop, and expand products based on customer feedback and the needs of the shooting sports industry.
